### Go Vote!

John Wesley (along with his brother Charles) was founder of the Methodist movement 300 years ago. Wesley was a man who was devoted to Scripture and prayer and offered profound wisdom on how to live as followers of Jesus Christ.

We can also glean from his wisdom on elections and voting. In Wesley's personal journal, an entry dated October 6,1774 says:

I met those of our society who had votes in the ensuing election, and advised them:

- · To vote, without fee or reward, for the person they judged most worthy.
- · To speak no evil of the person they voted against.
- · To take care their spirits were not sharpened against those that voted on the other side.

Wesley's advice is good for us in this divisive moment. Next Tuesday is Election Day in America. Voting is a right and a privilege. Exercise your right to vote! When you vote next Tuesday, vote for the person you deem "most worthy," but don't speak evil of the one you "vote against" or those who vote differently from you. Recently I shared with our Church Council that both Presidential candidates have good and bad qualities and neither political party is God's favorite.

At Christ United, we have members on both sides of the political spectrum. Just because someone has a different political view than ours doesn't disqualify them from being a child of God. If we identify more with our political passions than our identity in Christ - then something's out-of-whack with our lives.

Whoever wins the election, whether it's the person I vote for or not, I'm going to accept it peacefully. The sun is still going to come up on November 4th and the sky isn't going to fall. God will still be God and worthy of our devotion and service. Whoever wins won't affect who the Church is and what our mission is.

So go vote next Tuesday and act like a follower of Jesus.


### **Register for In-person Worship on Sunday Mornings**


### How to Cancel Your Worship Ticket
